

**NOTE:** How to determine if your **iMac** or **Macbook Pro** has a **32-bit** or **64-bit** Processor

1. Hold down the Option key and choose System Information or System Profiler from the Apple menu.
2. Select the Hardware section of the window that appears.
3. Locate the Processor Name.
4. Compare your Processor Name to information below to determine whether your Mac has a 32-bit or 64-bit processor.

Processor Name	32- or 64-bit
Intel Core Solo	32 bit
Intel Core Duo	32 bit
Intel Core 2 Duo	64 bit
Intel Quad-Core Xeon	64 bit
Dual-Core Intel Xeon	64 bit
Quad-Core Intel Xeon	64 bit

Core i5	64 bit
Core i7	64 bit






Click on the **Download** tab.




On the top right corner of your screen you should see your file being download

**Double left click** here




Click on Agree

**NOTE:** The VMWare Horizon icon  maybe on your desktop. Double click it.




Click on **Open**



If this window appears click **Continue**


In the top left corner double left click on the **view.grapevintexas.gov** icon




Then click **Login**
